

# Visiting Cleethorpes Library Sensory Room

Cleethorpes Library is easily accessible by public transport, there are buses that stop directly outside, and the train station is approx. 5 minutes' walk away. There is a car park at the rear of the library with a few spaces for library users and a public pay and display car park, both of which are accessible from Yarra Road.

If you need to follow directions on an app like google maps it leads you directly outside the front entrance.



## Entering the building

To enter the building you go through two automatic doors.



The main library reception desk on the right-hand-side as you enter.  
Staff are always on hand to help and assist.



Access and pathways are nice and clear leading to the Sensory Room and the library is all on one level.



The Sensory Room is at the back of the library, near the computer suite. As you walk towards the sensory room you can follow the coloured circle footprints on the floor, and these will take you straight there. Please remember not to take food or drink into the room.



## What's inside the Sensory Room

There is a comfy beanbag and cushions, where you can sit.

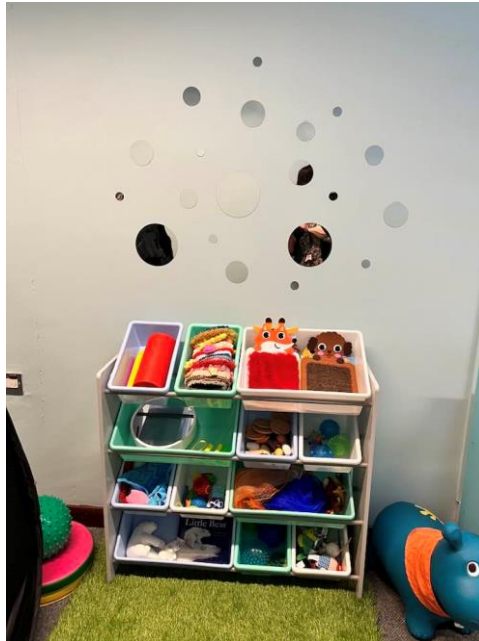


There are also some comfy chairs and a weighted lap pad.

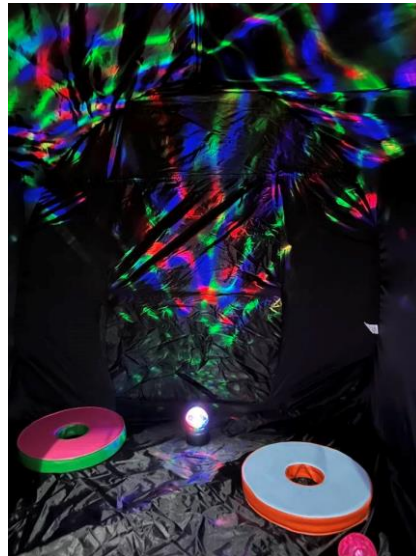


There is sensory lighting and a sound machine. Staff can show you how to use these when you arrive.
